No-one can stop you reading Ansible. And if you don't like the way Dave Langford presents the news, no power on earth can stop you putting out your own newzine. It's easy. If you don't own a typewriter, a duplicator, a stapler, you know someone who does. And you live in a society which at least pays lipservice to the idea of a free press- and you're part of a subculture (fandom) which puts the idea into practice.

Just a goddam hobby. But in Poland, the free trade union movement (Solidarity) is being stifled by lack of the hardware of communication. Which means: type-writers, duplicators, staplers. Not to mention stencils, ink, paper and staples. The Soviets see to it that you can't just go into Rymanski's and buy these dangerous things over there. Denying access to printing materials is as effective a way of shutting someone up as kicking them in the mouth.

Solidarity has appealed to its friends abroad to send printing machines and stationery. Fans, as major beneficiaries of the free press, ought to contribute. Quickly. Any minute the tanks could roll in....
